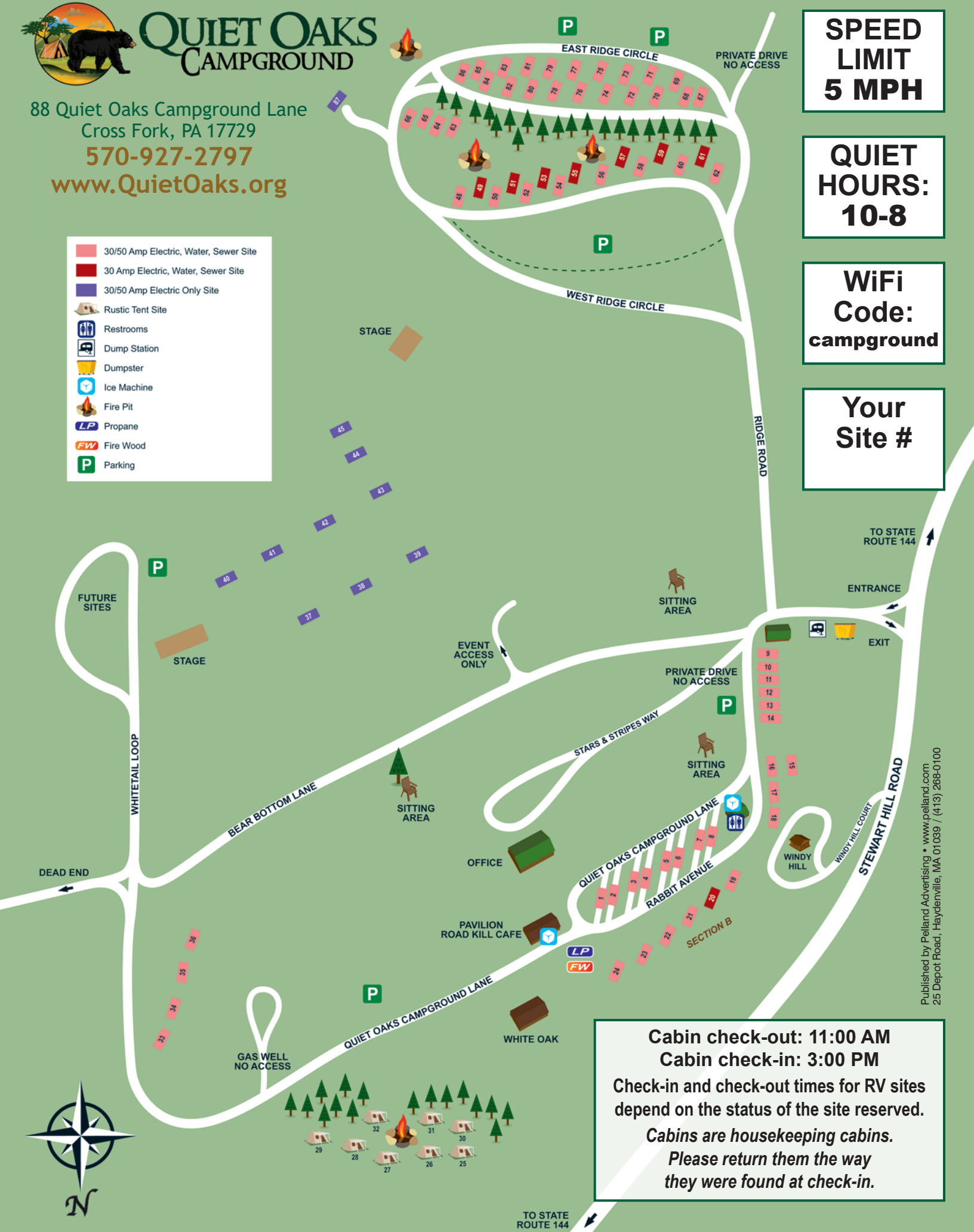

QUIET OAKS CAMPGROUND GUIDELINES AND REGULATIONS

Quiet Oaks should be an enjoyable experience for everyone. For your safety and protection of the venue, there are a few guidelines that we are asking everyone to follow. Doing so will help make the Quiet Oaks Campground a wonderful experience.

Four Wheelers, Golf Carts & ATVs: Guests will be permitted to operate motorized recreational vehicles (ATVs, golf carts, etc.) at QOCG on the designated roads. These vehicles are to be used for travel from place to place, no racing around. Operators are subject to the laws of PA, with all operators 10 and under being required to have a legal adult with them to operate the machines. No motorized vehicles permitted in our fields. Please allow the wild animals to safely appear and graze.

Pets: Pets are allowed in the campground, with all of our campsites and cabins being pet-friendly. No exotic pets are permitted. Please control your pets at all times – by leash or by command. If your pet is unable to be controlled (barking, growling, lunging, etc.), please remove it from the campground. Please clean up after your pets!

Loud Fireworks & Floating Flames are Prohibited: Setting off loud fireworks will result in expulsion from the campground. This includes mini hot air balloons that are set adrift to float in the breeze. The noise and the potential fire hazard pose too great a risk.

Kegs: Do not bring kegs to the campground.

This is a LITTER FREE CAMPGROUND: Please help contain your trash. Recycle all aluminum. Take out what you bring in. Use the trash bins located at the entrance to the grounds.

Vehicles: Only vehicles belonging to campers are allowed in the camping area. Please use the excess parking area for trailers, boats, and guests.

Music: Please limit the volume of stereos or car systems within the quiet hours.

Campfires: Ground fires must be contained with a well-built fire ring. Using a raised fire pit is suggested. All fires must be properly barricaded and contained. Share a fire with your camping neighbor whenever possible, so we don't have fires everywhere. Fires are subject to statewide burn bans.

Noise in the Campground: Quiet hours are from 10:00 PM to 8:00 AM. Please be respectful of fellow campers, keep your music/entertainment and yelling to a minimum.

Weapons: All weapons should be secured from direct access until the intended use. They should be stored unloaded and away from children.

No Illegal Substances: No exceptions ~ you will be asked to leave the campground, without refund.
